

### 6. Training, Nutrition and Healthcare

### 8. Dog Tag / Microchip

### 10. Home Check-ins and Inspection

**We believe the first 48 hours of introducing yourself to your newly adopted dog is very critical and we need to make sure that the introduction takes place in a safe and proper way especially after your dogs are under a severe stress after the long flight.**

- To give yourself and your new companion dog an easier start, can you make time to spend the first 48 hours without interruptions i.e. can you take 2 days off from work and engage in NO OTHER social event, NO VISITORS for those 2 days? (Y/N) Y

- If you are not able to take 2 days off from your work, can any experienced adult among your family members/ roommates stay at home, as an observer and liaison, instead of you? (In this case, please be sure that the person must keep the distance, as written below 1) to 3), from the adopted dog and doesn't attempt to touch the dog.)

**For us to help you and monitor exactly what circumstances you and the adopting dog are facing, please agree to send us the photos and/or videos of the dog at the following situation:**

- 1) right after you meet the dog while it is in the kennel
- 2) right after you open the kennel at home (please just open the door and move back to give space for your dog to check out new surroundings)
- 3) right after the dog walks out of its kennel on its own (do NOT try to force the dog out of the kennel, do NOT stick your head or hands inside the kennel. However, you CAN offer water/food/treats/toys in front of the kennel.)

- Yes, I understand what I need to do when I first meet my adopted dog and will send you the photos/videos at the situation described on above. ML (PLEASE INITIAL)

**One of our pride and joy is to see how well adjusted and happy our rescues are with their new human companions. To ensure the safety and well-being of our rescue dogs, we would ask you to keep in touch and update us with our progress and daily lives of your adopted rescue dog.**

- o Please ensure that you will post photos/videos of the adopted dog on our facebook on the first day (as above), third day, one week, two weeks and one month after arrival.
- o Since that, during the first year, we require that you send us pictures /videos at least **once every month**.
- o From the second year, we require that you send pictures/video and progress updates at least **every 2 months**.

- Yes, I understand it and will share the photos/videos in timely manner. ML (PLEASE INITIAL)

- Are you willing to accept and abide by sending us continuous updates until the very end? Yes

- Is there anything else you would like us to know, suggest or wish to disclose to our organization? If so, please write in detail below.

- Before finalizing the adoption, we may require a home inspection. Do you consent? (Y/N) Y
